NMIMS Mumbai Library Workshop on Academic Integrity in the age of Artificial Intelligence on 17th February, 2024

The NMIMS central library and Turnitin hosted a workshop on "Academic Integrity in the Age of Al" on February 17, 2024, at the Mumbai campus, which was well-attended by library professionals. The workshop covered the details of maintaining academic integrity, the severe problems with plagiarism, and the imminent risks of predatory journals. This expanded the information and awareness required for a successful educational path.





Ms. Purna Bose from Turnitin led the first session, explained the importance of academic integrity, how to distinguish between plagiarism and text similarity, provided criteria for academic integrity by Indian education governance generative AI, and explained the role of AI.



Prof. Prabhash Rath of the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics in Pune, who discussed ethical research standards in the age of AI and digital writing tools, led the second session. The session helped participants comprehend the moral implications, problems, and duties associated with technological advancement and how to navigate the frontiers of research with integrity and mindfulness. This workshop provides an ethical framework to guide researchers through the rapidly growing field of AI-driven research.





Dr. Shamprasad Pujar, Chief Librarian at IGIDR, led the third interactive session. This session gave participants hands-on experience with AI tools and their diverse toolboxes.

The workshop assisted in navigating the forefront of technological change, revealing Al's ability to shape the future. The session benefited all library professionals by keeping them up-to-date on trends in the library field.

A report of the 2024 National Librarian's Day event from the NMIMS Bangaluru campus On 12th August, 2024











Report on Librarians Day and NMIMS Library Week Celebration Shirpur Campus On 12th August, 2024 to 17th August 2024



Independence Day Online Quiz done by R. M. Desai Library on 15th August ,2024



Conclusion and Recommendations:







Guide to Use The EPWRF India Time Series Statistical Database

The EPWRF India Times Series, an interactive online database launched in January 2011. It is an initiative taken by the EPW Research Foundation (EPWRF) with an aim to provide time series data facilitating research across various sectors of the Indian Economy. It is a unique online database with comprehensive coverage of the Indian economy for a fairly long time period, and it comprises over a lakh variable capsuled in 27 modules. The EPWRF India Times Series tries to provide a continuous time series from 1950 depending on the availability. The database is well-accepted by the research community in India as well as abroad. Major subscribers include several Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) institutes and Universities (central, state, and private), IIMs, IITs, Banks, and topranked management institutes.




Fig 2: Landing page of EPWRF India Time Series Database

After login you will get the following screen. You will get module list on the left side of the screen.




Fig 4: Shows Modules list on the left side

Select Module from module list. You can select the module by clicking on browse link. You will get module description on right side of the screen.




Fig 5: Shows how to Browse the required module




Fig 6: Shows how to browse sub-modules

- Now Select the nodes and click on "Submit" button.






Fig 7: Shows how to select variables from the tree view

After clicking on the "Submit" button, you will get the following screen.




- § Result Window: It shows the data available for the selected criteria.

- § Save Query Button: If you want to save the result query with parameters then click on this button.




