Change in Duration of Program is applicable for UG program of School of Commerce (SOC), School of Economics (SOE), Jyoti Dalal School of Liberal Arts (JDSOLA), Nilkamal School of Mathematics, Applied Statistics & Analytics and School of Branding and Advertising (SOBA).

In accordance with NEP 2020 guidelines, NMIMS University has introduced a 4-year duration degree program (UG) from the academic year 2024-2025 with a focus on research / multi-disciplinary focus in the 4th Year. The students successfully completing this program will be offered Honor's degree in their respective disciplines. Students will be provided with exit option after 3 years. A student pursuing a 3-year degree will not be eligible Hons. Degree. Students who are interested in pursuing a four-year Hons. Degree have to indicate their preference at the end of the 2nd year of the three-year program.

- NMIMS reserves all the rights to alter intake / number of Specialization at any point of time.
- Program will commence only if there are a minimum 50% of intake capacity per specialization / program,
 admitted after the selection process. NMIMS reserves rights in this regard.

For candidate of International Baccalaureate

- The candidate of International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate / & D.P (Diploma awarded) candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10+2 or equivalence examination with 24 grades/credits compulsory and has passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and TOK and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- DP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Boards are considered to 10 +2 or equivalence
 examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at
 Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate
 marks.
- IBCP equivalence for General Strand (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand: CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB. Further eligibility criteria as stipulated by statuary bodies like AICTE and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- 2.2 Candidates of CBSE & ICSE, should mention in online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10th / 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all subjects for which candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of Four, Five, Six or Seven). The candidates shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared will be taken into consideration & PCM % for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- 2.3 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 2.4 Candidate above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 2.5 Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate): Candidates offered admission on the basis of SAT /ACT merit list & who have not received final marksheet till then will be given PROVISIONAL Admission based on predicted score. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed only on submission of final marksheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible.
- 2.6 Marksheet / Transcripts issued by Board/University only be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted)

- 2.7 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10+2 or equivalent examination from overseas board / Universities
- 2.8 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board/University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA / CGPA obtained.
- 2.9 Candidates whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to upload internet copy / DG Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program.
- 2.10 Only single marksheet from a single board with all compulsory subjects taken and passed is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.
- 2.11 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the marksheet / grade sheet.
 For absent / Ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidates is declared as pass by respective board.
- 2.12 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.
- 2.13 The candidate must have appeared for all his subject(s) / exams before the commencement of the respective program (s) of NMIMS (Deemed to be University). The examination of none of the subjects should be held after the commencement of the respective course.
- 2.14 The candidate must have appeared for all his subject(s) / exams before the candidates whose final mark sheet of the qualified examination is not available at the time of their provisional admission, is required to submit their final marksheet copy as soon as the result declared. In such case, if the candidate fails to meet the required eligibility criteria, then his admission will be cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund rules (even after course commencement).

3. Admission Process:

Online Registration & Payment of Fees:

- Visit <u>www.nmims.edu</u> for online registration.
- Before filling the online form, please read all the instructions carefully mentioned in the instruction sheet, important dates and also Terms & Condition given in the online application form.
- Online registration fee of Rs. 2,000 / which is non-refundable / nontransferable
- Candidate can give two preferences across the schools.
- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the SAT Score & preference of program / campus given in online registration form by candidate.
- Valid SAT / ACT Score since August-2023 will be considered for Merit process.

- The candidate should convert their ACT marks into SAT marks as per Concordance Table approved by College Board and ACT; and enter in the registration form accordingly.
- NMIMS reserves right to decide school-wise merit cut-off; subject to intake / vacant seats availability.

4. Selection Process:

Cut off marks will be declared at the time of admission only.

For MPSTME / STME:

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate in SAT exam.
- In the counseling session candidates will be given admission to various disciplines as per their merit, choice and availability of discipline as per eligibility criteria.
- The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained

Note:

- Candidates are required to update 12th or equivalent exam or predicted marks after the admission process.
- Candidate will not be considered for merit list if they fail to update the correct information in the online registration form.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- At any given point of time if it is found that the information given by candidate i.e 12th or
 equivalent exam / SAT Score is incorrect, the candidate admission will be cancelled and fees
 will be refunded as per prescribed refund rules.
