1. To confirm the minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 25 August 2017:


The minutes of the last meeting were circulated. Since no comments were received, the minutes were confirmed.

2. **Institution of new programs:** The members deliberated on the need for collaborative, interdisciplinary, and technology driven pedagogy. They felt that with the given proactive and supportive management, NMIMS can become a leader in starting a School of Performing Arts offering the program, Bachelor of Performing Arts-BPA (Music). The

members suggested that the School of Performing Arts at NMIMS will be a boon for students who love to pursue their passion of Music. The members also proposed to start a new program Master of Management Studies (MMS) from academic year 2018-19.

3. **Starting of Centre of Excellence in Analytics and Data Science:** A Centre of Excellence in Analytics and Data Science has been established. The center is designed as a cross-functional shared services structure for fueling innovative development & deployment of curriculum, projects, teaching and training across the needs of the Schools of NMIMS and industry in field of Analytics and Data Sciences.
4. **Introduction of Choice Based Credit System Courses (CBCS):** Looking into the interest of the students to learn various courses in other streams as Interdisciplinary courses, NMIMS has thought of offering Choice Based Credit System Courses to students of various programs from the academic year 2018-19.
5. **Use of Innovations in Teaching Pedagogy:** Various innovations in teaching pedagogy are being used by Schools and campuses. They have offered innovative courses to meet the requirements of the industry and to make the students employable, like Hackathon, Simulations, field projects and online courses on MOOC(Swayam) platform.
