


SHARING EXPERIENCES WITH THE LIBRARY

Just like the students, the institute and The NMIMS Libraries were also excited to welcome students back to Campus after a long online stretch of online classes and vacations.


To help students express their thoughts in a better way, the Library conducted an activity wherein the students could freely express how they felt resuming back physically to Campus.

Let's have a look at what they have to say about missing the Campus and the Library!




To come back to college, it felt like coming home. To feel in a classroom, in a canteen, on lectures.




After Resuming back, it feels very relaxing to come collage after long time. We get a silent environment in the library. Back to campus felt like home and overall a very refreshing feeling.



1. Where can I get daily news and the latest information related to my interest/field?

Ans – The Library holds a variety of print and online journals to get the market information. As well as, you can update yourself with the latest information by visiting the Library and reading various Newspapers on a daily basis.

2. How do I check Titles/Books available in the Library?

Ans - The library collections are fully searchable using the [NMIMS Online Catalog](#) of the combined collections. Also under this section you can login into Library account using your credentials to check the books issued by you earlier.

3. How can I access/ log-in to the E-Library?

*Ans- You can access the E-Library using [NMIMS e-Library](#) Link, click on **Login**, Select the **LDAP** option on the left, and enter your login credentials.*

For faculties/staff –

Username and password would be same as their office machine credentials

For Students –

Username – SAPID@svkgrp.com

Password – Wi-Fi password given by the institution.

4. Where can I access Harvard Business Review Journals?

Ans – The Harvard publication is available in full- text from 1922 to the present through the EBSCO database. Under the EBSCO database, you can click on (third option from the top left) "Publications and choose Business Source Premier – Publications" (Form the dropdown); similarly, you can access the journals directly (if the publication is known) from our various e-journal databases like EBSCO and ProQuest

5. How do I find which database is suitable for finding the desired information?

Ans- There's a Quick usage guide available under the Library Resources tab on the student portal; referring to the manual will guide you to the correct database.

6. Where can I find Last Year's Questions papers?

Ans – In the student portal, you can refer the tab named "Library Documents" for all the previous years' question papers.







Fig. 1 shows ProQuest Central under Electronic Journal Databases & ProQuest Ebrary under E-Book Database



ProQuest Central: Basic Search

Search across all **ProQuest** platform databases with the Basic Search. You can search **All** source types or limit your search by a source type such as Scholarly Journals, Videos & Audio, Dissertations & Theses, Books, and others available through the **More** menu. Additionally, you can limit your search to items containing **Full text** from ProQuest and **Peer Reviewed** articles to only find documents reviewed by subject matter experts. If you only search a single database directly, you will not see the source type selections.


