WHAT IS OPEN ACESS PUBLISHING

Something more than just freely available materials...

We all use and read articles openly available to us, but do we know the in-depth system of how it works?

- ➤ Open Access resources are well-known in the information era. Open-access resources are a treasure of knowledge that aids researchers in many ways; we have free access to scholarly journals via the internet, and more and more scholars are reaping the benefits of these resources, which encouraged the open-access publishing concept.
- ➤ Open access is a broad international movement that seeks to grant free and open online access to academic information, such as publications and data.
- ➤ A publication is defined as 'open access' when there are no financial, legal or technical barriers to accessing it that is to say, when anyone can read, download, copy, distribute, print, search for and search within the information, or use it in education or in any other way within the legal agreements.
- ➤ The principles of open access are set out in the Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities (2003).

Our mission of disseminating knowledge is only half complete if the information is not made widely and readily available to society." - Berlin Declaration.

> OA is a newer form of scholarly publishing. Many OA journals comply with well-established peer-review processes and maintain high publishing standards.


Benefits of Open Access Publishing

- > Publishing your work in open access helps to establish your societal identity in the field of research.
- ➤ Open access increases the visibility of your research by allowing more people to read and download it, which helps to increase your citations.
- ➤ It aids in inter-disciplinary research and encourages more people to think outside the box.
- > Open access publishing enhances scientific knowledge by providing free access; it helps to strengthen research.
- > Open access articles are downloaded and cited by many people, enhancing an individual's work visibility and impact.
- > Open access creates a new pathway for discovery in the digital environment.




TYPES OF OPEN ACCESS PUBLISHING

There are different ways to choose from while publishing in Open-Access.

Gold Open Access Publishing

✓ Gold open access publishing indicates that the final article will be free and fully available to everyone, however this also follows a proper process for which the author has to pay some amount of fees known as APC – Article Publishing Cost. This cost is used for the publishing works required by the publisher to publish an article. This is one of the most open, least restrictive types of open access. By publishing through this, the author can increase the outreach of their research work.

Green Open Access Publishing

✓ This is when the accepted article is first deposited into a subject-based repository or an institution's repository, which then often specifies how the article may be used. This is simpler words means Self-Archiving, it is the practice of archiving an earlier version of your manuscript in repositories and online of the article and then publishing it. This saves the author from the APC.

Diamond Open Access Publishing

✓ This refers to journals that provide free access for readers, but also for research authors to publish in. Although the name is slightly deceiving, diamond open access journals are supported by institutions or other infrastructures, hence they may not have a high-impact factor. It is an open-access publisher of peer-reviewed journals. Diamond Scientific Publishing is dedicated to promoting open scholarly research all around the world. Diamond Open Access does not charge authors any fees; rather, funding from outside sources covers the costs of publishing.

Hybrid Open Accessing

✓ A hybrid open access publishing model is one in which subscription-based journals allow authors to immediately make individual articles gold open access upon payment of an article publication charge. Although the processing fees may be higher than that of a regular open access journal, it may be worth the effort if your article fits the journal's aims and scope perfectly.

❖ BLACK OPEN ACCESSING

✓ This is an illegal open access model, where although the article is not openly licensed, it is still shared by illicit services that offer free access to scientific publications or other content (e.g., Sci-Hub).

ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES OF OPEN ACCESS PUBLISHING OPTIONS

1. Gold Open Access Publishing Advantages:

- Increased Publication and usage
- Retention of copyright
- Faster Impact

Disadvantages:

• It is expensive

2. Green Open Access Publishing *Advantages:*

- It costs less or sometimes even free
- The author can choose a subscriptionbased journal for the article while also making the article open access

Disadvantages:

- The embargo period is lengthy
- Re-use rights not as extensive

3. Diamond Open Access Publishing *Advantages:*

- Increased transparency
- It is Gold open access without fees

Disadvantages:

- Receives limited funding
- Sustaining Publishing operations may be difficult over long period of time.

4. Hybrid Open Access Publishing <u>Advantages:</u>

- With Creative Commons licenses, it is simple to comply with open access mandates.
- High-quality and authoritative publishing standards, as well as rigorous peer-review.

Disadvantages

- Different levels of access
- More Expensive
- Does not necessarily transition to open-access

How do we identify policies of different Journals?

- ➤ Open access tools are the ones which aggregates data from various websites and help the user by pointing out the information obtained in one place.
- ➤ Similarly, there is software which aggregates journal policies and what the final policy of the article would be used.
- To know more we have a database which aggregates all the publisher policies and tells us about various copyright, self-archiving policies of academic journals.

<u>SHERPA/RoMEO- (Securing a Hybrid Environment for Research Preservation and Access / Rights Metadata for Open Archiving)</u>

- ➤ Sherpa Romeo is an online resource that aggregates and analyses publisher open access policies from around the world and provides summaries of publisher copyright and open access archiving policies on a journal-by-journal basis.
- ➤ It is an online resource that aggregates and presents publisher and journal open access policies from around the world.
- ➤ Every registered publisher or journal held in Romeo is carefully reviewed and analysed by our specialist team who provide summaries of self-archiving permissions and conditions of rights given to authors on a journal-by-journal basis where possible.
- ➤ The policy information provided through this service primarily aims to serve the academic research community.

1. SHERPA JULIET

Sherpa Juliet is a searchable database and single focal point of up-to-date information concerning research funders' policies and their requirements on open access, publication and data archiving.


2. SHERPA FACTS

Sherpa Fact checks if compliance with funder open access policies can be achieved with a particular journal. Sherpa Fact is an online resource that combines and interprets data from Sherpa Romeo, Sherpa Juliet and other sources to provide clear guidance to researchers

3. OPENDOAR

OpenDOAR is the quality-assured global directory of academic open access repositories. It enables the identification, browsing and search for repositories, based on a range of features, such as location, software or type of material held.

- Policy records contain information on how articles can be made open access for the published, submitted and accepted versions of an article
- ➤ Policies are stored on Sherpa Romeo as a set of pathways, each pathway presenting a way in which a document can become open access
- ➤ Authors can refer to these pathways to understand how to make their article open access

Properties within pathways are represented by icons to give users a condensed summary of publisher policies.


The Pathways tells the author the different ways in which the articles can be made open access depending upon publisher requirements, and funders.

The accepted pathways are mentioned in the form of Pathway a, Pathway b, and so on.

The author may follow Pathway depending on whom the article is funded by and other measures.

This database thus aggregates various journals and gives us the copyright and other policies on one click.




BEWARE OF PREDATORY JOURNALS/PUBLICATIONS



- > Predatory Publishing refers to opportunistic publishing where the publisher uses author's research work and money to publish in a poor rated journal.
- ➤ It is basically the publisher charges the money from the authors, as it recognizes the need of publications for the authors.
- > Such publications are not listed and the authors time, efforts and money is wasted on the other hand the publishers earn a lot of money taking advantage of the need of publications for researchers.
- > The Predatory Publications do not have an editorial board and do not have peerreview system due to this the work of the author is published after charging a hefty amount from the authors but the work is not recognized as such journals are not listed anywhere and hence no credits are given to the author.
- > The phenomenon of "open access predatory publishers" was first noticed by Jeffrey Beall, when he described "publishers that are ready to publish any article for payment.





Characteristics of Predatory Journals

- ➤ Usually, PJs invite authors via emails and social media platforms to paper submission.
- No editor/ editorial board or peer review, Quick acceptance and publish articles
- > No editorial boards or fake members on the board
- > Confusing journal websites, which are having dead links, misspellings, and grammatical errors
- Make unauthorized use of licensed images
- Republish papers already published in other journals
- ➤ Huge publication charges
- Display fake impact factors
- > Display fake claims of its content indexed in indexing services
- Provide no copy edition or proofreading of submissions
- ➤ Using ISSN improperly, Confusing 'contact us' details

To avoid PJ's HRD ministry advised UGC to identify scholarly journals and make a UGC-approved list of journals for scholarly publications. To publish a paper mere ISSN number is not enough, the journal should be indexed in globally accepted indexing databases like Scopus, Web of Science, etc.





Here are some of the common questions answered about the Open Access Publishing ©

1. What is the benefit of publishing in open access?

Ans: there are seamless benefits like the research work get more visibility, similarly availability of other research articles and it allows multi-disciplinary research.

2. Is open Access Journal completely free to publish?

Ans: Open Access Journals give the liberty to read, download and reuse with some licensing terms of the Journal.

3. Is it good to publish in Open Access?

Ans: Open Access allows access to all users like researchers, teachers, publishers to eliminate subscription barriers thus research gaining more visibility.

4. What is the disadvantage of Open Access Publishing?

Ans: The quality concern is a major disadvantage as it is always a concern and questioned. Apart from this, if the researcher is going for gold access publishing, he/she may have to pay APC.

5. What are the examples of Open Access Publishers?

Ans: Some of the common examples are Springer, Elsevier, Wiley, Taylor & Francis group, Nature Publishing, SAGE and Oxford University Press.

6. Is Scopus an Open Access Journal?

Ans: On the Scopus document details page there is an "Open Access" label displayed to indicate that a document is Open Access. On the Scopus document search results pages there is a "Open Access" label in each separate line item if a document is Open Access. 7. How does open access affect the impact factor?

Ans: Where open access journals do have an Impact Factor, these could be higher or lower than subscription journals in the same field. 
8. What is the difference between Copyright and Open Access Publishing?

Ans: Publishing a work in the public domain has some relaxation from copyright as they work creative commons licenses the open access work is also protected by copyright laws with some leverages.



TURNITIN USAGE OF THE QUARTER


The below report states the number of users who have checked their work for plagiarism using Turnitin software.

The below report shows the overall usage of Turnitin








Fig 2: Landing page of ISI Emerging Markets Database




Fig 3: Shows search results for a Company e.g. Reliance Industries Ltd.




Fig 4: Shows Company Screener Tool.




Fig 5: View of Industry Statistics & Forecasts or Macro Stats & Forecasts .




Fig 3: Shows search results for All News.

The below table shows the number of orientation and training sessions for the usage of the library conducted across various campuses to improve the efficient use of eresources in the last quarter.


