

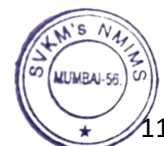
Details of the event

Objectives of the Event: Bring together individuals, organizations, and communities to support a common cause and educate the community about the importance of regular blood donation and its impact on saving lives.

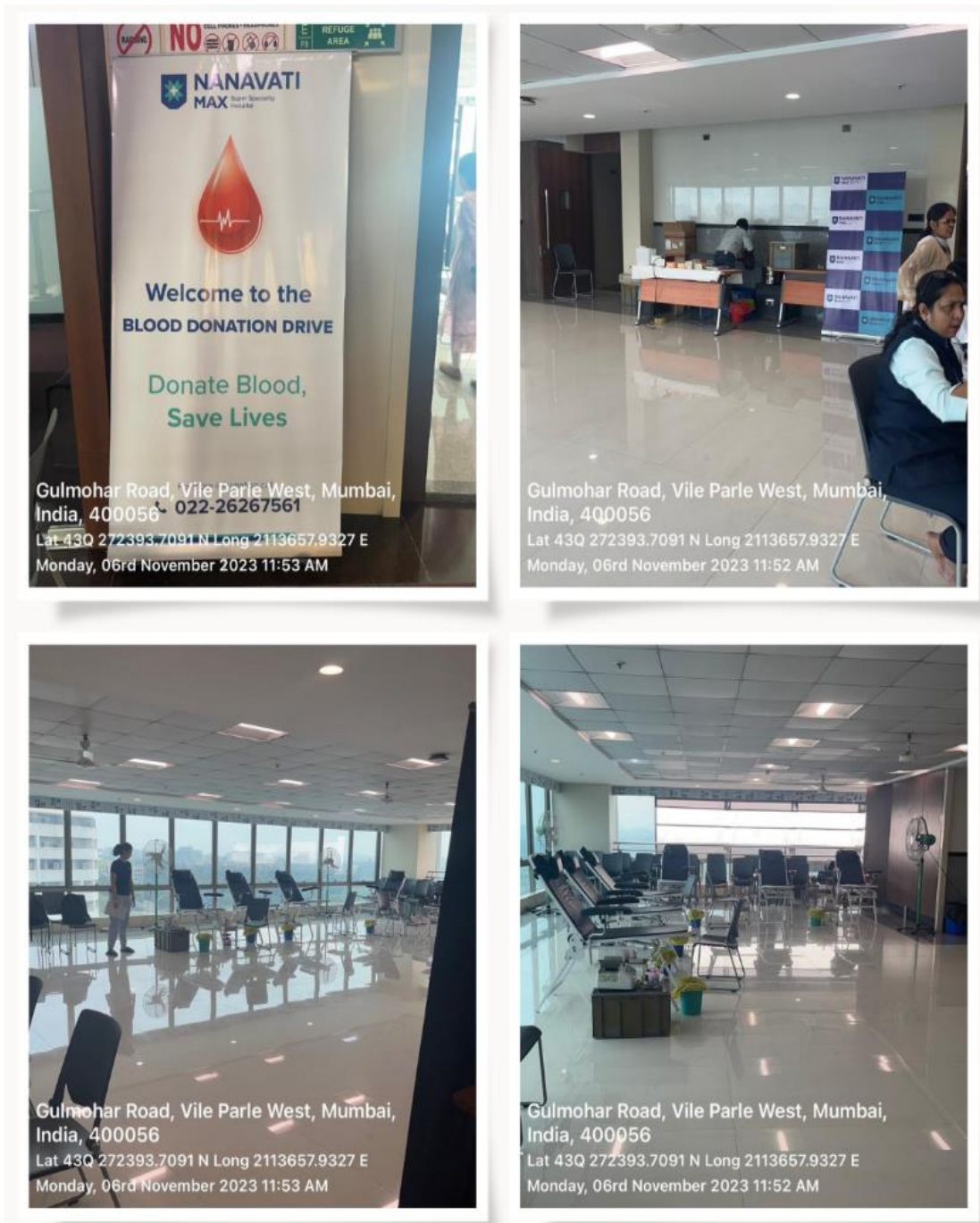

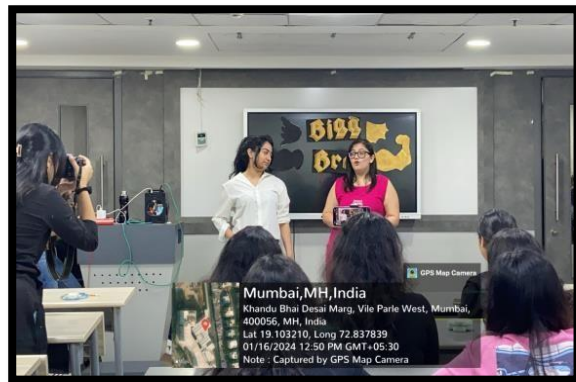
