

Shastrarth '20 proved to be a perfect prototype of a platform which provides the participants with an opportunity to put their articulating and debating skills to a rigorous test. In a year of sudden upheavals and uncertainty caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the inter college debating fest of Sarla Anil Modi School of Economics achieved was conducted online for the first time on the 10th October, 2020, on the virtual events platform. The event saw a total of 402 registrations by participants from different states in India, as well as two foreign registrations. The preliminary round followed the Oxford-style of debating with the semi-finals and finals being conducted in a unique Lincoln-Douglas format to harmonize with the online platform. Shastrarth'20 proved to be a holistic evaluation of oration and articulation, where teams were judged on the basis of their overall stance as well as points of contention. It turned out to be a feverish battle with contemporary topics spanning across science & technology, economics & business, societal behaviour & culture, global political landscape, education, environment, law & order, with the semi-finals and finals zeroing in on the landmark events of 2020. Articulating the most pressing policy issue that has assumed center stage this year, the topic for the finals was – "This house believes that the pandemic has exposed the need to revise the growth-centred development model in favour of a resilience-based one.". The event thus lived up to its motto.


