- The minutes of the last meeting were circulated. Since no comments were received, the minutes were confirmed.
- 2. Increase in the research productivity index: NMIMS encouraged their faculty to publish in prestigious indexed publications with high impact factor. This led to a considerable increase in the research productivity index of the University in 2021-22.

- 3. **NMIMS faculty Achievement**: Stanford University, together with Elsevier, has been creating a list of 2% of the best scientists in the world. Three of NMIMS University Pharmacy Professors, Dr. Pravin Shende and Dr. Yogesh Kulkarni and Dr. Ajazuddin featured in this list.
- MoU for Interdisciplinary Research: MPSTME, Mumbai campus signed MoU with Tata Memorial Cancer Hospital Mumbai for research activity in the interdisciplinary domain of Engineering and Medical Sciences.
- 5. Award of British Council Grant: NMIMS University & University of Bristol have been awarded the British Going Global Partnerships for Exploratory Grant of 15000 Pounds for creating joint courses and meeting global standards. The key objective is to enhance opportunities for students in India and the UK to have an international learning experience.
